Profile

Born in Tokyo. After graduating from Hitotsubashi University's Faculty of Social Sciences, he joined the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. He studied Arabic in Cairo and specialized in modern Middle Eastern history at Oxford University. He then worked at the Japanese embassy in Saudi Arabia and Israel before taking charge of Middle Eastern relations with the Security Council at the Permanent Mission of Japan to the United Nations. After serving as Director of the International Information Division at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Minister at the Embassy of Japan in the United Arab Emirates, and Cabinet Counsellor, he was appointed Minister at the Embassy of Japan in Thailand in 2012. In 2015, he was appointed as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to Oman, and in 2018, he was appointed as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to the Islamic Republic of Iran. He retired from the diplomatic service in 2020, and in 2021, he became a part-time lecturer at Toyo Eiwa University and a commentator at the Okazaki Institute.
